**Hotel reservations**

Due to Israel MOH Covid 19 guidance- upon your arrival, you will be required to take a PCR test. This test is in addition to the one that you need to take up to 72 hrs. before departure to Israel.

This requirement applies to all travelers, including vaccinated and recovered travelers. The results will be mailed to you within 24-36 hrs. and until then you are confined to stay in isolation in your hotel room.

This is the reason your arrival date has to be on **May 10<sup>th</sup>**.
